

FIREWORK GUIDELINES

Fireworks are allowed at Hedsor throughout the year, and they can be booked through your Wedding Specialist at the time of booking your wedding or at a later date.

There is a £1,600 facilitation fee (inc VAT) in 2024, or £1,700 facilitation fee (inc VAT) in 2025. £1,000 of this fee is donated to our Charity of the Year, details of which may be found on our website hedsor.com.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

MLE Pyrotechnics Ltd are the **only** company allowed to put on displays at Hedsor.

You are required to choose a 'low noise' display. These displays omit the large bangs that disturb wildlife and neighbours.

Music accompaniment is allowed as long as it is played at a sensible level.

The fireworks must finish before 10pm and won't be allowed to take place if commencement starts after 10pm. Hedsor House reserves the right to cancel fireworks displays if deemed necessary.

In dry or extremely dry conditions, all parties booking fireworks need to be aware of the following:

MLE Pyrotechnics may (if deemed necessary or at the request of Hedsor House) book a private fire engine to ensure the safety of the display. There is a cost of at least £1,000 (inc VAT) for this service, which would be charged to the client. By booking fireworks at Hedsor House, clients accept this condition.

MLE Pyrotechnics may (if deemed necessary or at the request of Hedsor House) cancel a display if the display is considered too risky (even with a fire engine on-site) due to the prevailing conditions. If this is the case, Hedsor House will refund the full Hedsor fireworks facility fee.

MLE Pyrotechnics may still charge for the display depending on when the decision to cancel has been made (as set out in their T&Cs).
